JAISHREE THAKUR, J. (Oral)

The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 171 dated 22.9.2018, under Section 498-A, 406, 323, 316/34 IPC registered at Police Station City Batala, District Batala.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the present FIR is the result of matrimonial discord and, in fact, a compromise has been entered into between the parties. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Mr. Amit Wadhwa, Advocate, who has put in appearance on

behalf of the complainant, admits the factum of the compromise and does not oppose to the prayer for grant of bail.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the compromise entered into between the parties, and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on their furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
