The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 15 dated 19.2.2018, under Sections 376, 452, 506 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Rampura, District Bathinda.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case. It is argued that the material witnesses have been examined. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Rajni Gupta, Sr. DAG, Punjab has contested the bail application, while submitting that the offence allegedly committed by the

petitioner is of serious nature.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the material witnesses have been examined and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
