Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No. 167 dated 15.11.2017, under Sections 332, 353, 427, 506 of IPC and Section 146 of Railway Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Rewari.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Narender Kumar who was working in the Railway Department. Allegations pertain to 15.11.2017 in the early morning hours against the present petitioner and co-accused Sanju who were stated to be under the influence of liquor and had beaten and abused the complainant by giving fist blows and having also damaged railway property/telephone wires etc.

Petitioner was arrested on 24.11.2017.

Investigation in the case is complete and the challan

already stands presented.

Till date charges have not been framed.

Trial as such would take time to conclude.

Learned State counsel who is on instructions from ASI Suresh Kumar, Police Station GRP, Rewari has produced for perusal of this Court an MLR of complainant-Narender Kumar and which reflects simple injury.

Without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Rewari.
