**Main Case**

Petitioner seeks regular bail pending trial in case FIR  
No.42 dated 07.09.2011, under Sections 395/412 IPC, registered at  
Police Station GRP, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Counsel for the parties have been heard.

FIR came to be registered on the statement of Kanchan  
Singh.

Allegations pertain to 23.08.2011 while the complainant was proceeding in a train from Delhi to Hisar. Allegations are that when the train stopped at Bahadurgarh, 10-12 unidentified boys boarded the train and resorted to snatching and beating of the passengers. From the complainant, a mobile make Nokia and Rs.2000/- were alleged to have been snatched. Even other passengers were stated to have been robbed in a similar fashion.

Petitioner having been arrested was granted benefit of bail. He, however, misused the concession and had been declared a proclaimed offender. Petitioner, thereafter was arrested on 05.10.2017 and has faced incarceration since then.

Counsel has during the course of arguments adverted to the judgment dated 03.09.2015 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jhajjar and whereby co-accused and against whom there were similar allegations have earned acquittal.

In the facts and circumstances noticed and without making any observations on merits, petitioner is held entitled to the benefit of bail.

Petitioner be enlarged on bail subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, Jhajjar.
