The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking interim bail to the petitioner for a period of four weeks.

Petitioner is an accused in FIR No.142, dated 27.11.2016, under Sections 307/392/223/224/120-B/148/149/201/419/170/171/353/186/212/216/489 IPC, Section 25 of the Arms Act and Sections 11/13/16/17/18/20 of the Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Act, registered at Police Station Kotwali, Nabha and is currently lodged in Central Jail, Patiala.

Interim bail for a period of four weeks is sought on the ground that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is to be solemnized on 24.02.2018.

Notice in the instant petition was issued.

A response on behalf of the State has been filed and placed on record.

The factum of marriage of the daughter of the petitioner to be

solemnized on 24.02.2018 has been verified. Even statements of certain respectables have been recorded and appended along with the reply.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from ASI Jaswant Singh during the course of hearing today has even informed the Court that investigation in the case is complete, challan has been presented and even charges have been framed.

In view of the averments made in the petition and submissions advanced by counsel, prayer for interim bail to the petitioner for a period of one week commencing from 20.02.2018 is allowed.

Petitioner be released on interim bail on 20.02.2018 subject to satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.

Petitioner would duly surrender on 27.02.2018 at 5 P.M. before the Jail authorities concerned.

Disposed of.
