Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not named in the FIR at all, however it is stated that one Achhu and two other boys went to the first floor of the house of one Bhagwan Dass and attacked his mother with a sword.

Learned counsel for the State submits that as a matter of fact the petitioner is one of those two boys, with the fingers of the mother of Bhagwan Dass, i.e. of Rajwati, having been severed, as also a blow having been given on the head of the complainant.

Though learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is living 2-3 houses away from the house of the aforesaid Bhagwan Dass and the complainant, and therefore he should have been named; however, in my opinion, it is not necessary that the name of every boy living in the neighbourhood would be known to all the neighbours.

Hence, considering the severity of the allegations made, without making any comment further, which would obviously be looked into by the trial Court, I consider it appropriate not to grant bail at this stage.

Consequently, dismissed.
