This is second petition for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in cross-case bearing DDR No.29 dated 05.07.2017 under Sections 326, 323, 324, 148, 149 IPC in FIR No.88 dated 11.06.2017 under Sections 307/34 IPC read with Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Patti, District Tarn Taran.

In the first anticipatory bail petition, notice of motion was issued and after hearing learned counsel for the parties, the same was dismissed as withdrawn on 05.12.2017.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that now Section 25 of the Arms Act has been deleted and considering the nature of injuries sustained by the victims Kuldeep Singh and Surender Singh, the petitioner has got new ground.

No fresh ground is made out to entertain the second/present petition for anticipatory bail, as all the arguments now sought to be raised in the present petition were heard and considered at the time of hearing the first petition.

Dismissed.
