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**ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)**

This is a petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to respondent No.1 to further direct the respondents No.2 to 4 to register a case FIR against the respondent No.5 under Sections 420, 323, 452, 365, 506 IPC, on the basis of the complaint given by the petitioner.

Reply by way of affidavit of DSP, Rohtak is on record and as per the reply, after receiving the complaint dated 24.08.2017 filed by the petitioner, a DDR No.3 dated 25.08.2017 was recorded and thereafter, an inquiry was conducted by the local police and allegations made in the complaint were found to be baseless. It is further stated in the affidavit that during the inquiry, the complainant, the respondent No.5 and the witnesses were duly issued notice and their statements were recorded, details is given in para No.2 of the affidavit. It is lastly submitted that as per the inquiry no such incident, as alleged in the complaint, was found to have taken place.

In view of the same, no further order is required to be passed in the present petition and the same is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioner to avail his legal remedy, in accordance with law.
