As per the stand of the State and so is the statement made by Mr. Rakeshinder Singh Sidhu, AAG, Punjab, on instructions of ASI Sukhdev Singh, Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda, that the police have found the petitioner-accused, innocent during investigation, on the grounds that in her stand taken in statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C., the girl Sandeep Kaur-respondent No.3, has denied the allegations levelled by respondent No.2 against the petitioner, and has taken the stand that she, at the time of this alleged occurrence, was major and has on her own voluntary free will and accord, has started living with the petitioner and that the police has found that no cause to initiate further action is necessitated and undertakes that cancellation report will be filed, positively, by all means, within one week from

today.

The State shall be bound by the statement.

In light of the above statement, learned counsel for the petitioner made statement withdrawing the present petition, however, reserving the rights of the petitioner to invoke the jurisdiction of this Court again, in case of any future eventuality.

Heard. Allowed.

Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
