Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a Criminal Complaint No.NACT 635 of 2014 titled as Tarsem Lal Versus Sunita, filed under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, which is pending in the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is an old lady and has been declared Proclaimed Person vide order dated 19.03.2018. She undertakes to appear before the trial Court and to face trial in accordance with law.

Notice of motion only to respondent No.2 at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is an old lady and the complainant-Tarsem Lal has filed a complaint under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, for an amount of Rs.50,000/-, present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a week from today, she shall be admitted on bail by the trial Court subject to her furnishing fresh bail bonds/surety bonds to its satisfaction. Petitioner shall also furnish an undertaking that she will not make herself absent in court proceedings without there being prior permission from the court.
