The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.170 dated 17.04.2018, registered under Sections 379-A, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC (Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC added later) at Police Station Baldev Nagar, District Ambala.

It is allegation against the unknown persons that they purchased gold jewellery worth Rs.36,73,000/- and even in lieu of that one person wearing the cap transferred an amount of Rs.26,50,000/- in the bank account of complainant but the said entry was found to be fake.

Learned State counsel has submitted that the said jewellery has already been recovered from the petitioner.

The petitioner is in custody since 22.06.2018. The trial of the case will take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case and

keeping in view the fact that conclusion of trial will take considerably long time, the present petition is allowed. Petitioner Rajeew Sharma is ordered to be released on regular bail on furnishing bail bond and surety bond to the satisfaction of concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, subject to following terms:-

- (a) The petitioner shall comply with the conditions mentioned in Section 437(3) Cr.P.C.*
- (b) In the event of his absence on any date of hearing, the benefit of bail allowed to the petitioner shall stand withdrawn. The trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail bond and surety bond and proceed to procure his presence in accordance with law. In that eventuality the petitioner shall have to apply for bail afresh.*
- (c) He shall not leave the country without the previous permission of the Court.*
- (d) He will maintain peace and be of good behaviour.*
