Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.70 dated 30.09.2018 under Sections 61 & 78(1) of Punjab Excise Act, 1914, registered at Police Station Jaurkian, District Mansa.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed on 19.11.2018: -

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail by the Additional Sessions Judge, Mansa, considering the fact that the recovery was already effected, however, on account of non-joining the investigation, said application was later on dismissed. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and appear before

the Investigating Officer.....”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Satpal Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioner is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.11.2018 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
