This is the second petition preferred by the petitioner under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of bail in FIR No.76 dated 03.11.2015, registered under Sections 15 and 25 of the NDPS Act, at P.S. City-I, District Mansa.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that the trial is at the fag end as out of eight prosecution witnesses, five witnesses already stand examined, whereas, one witness has been given up. The remaining two witnesses have been summoned for 27.11.2018 and 14.12.2018, respectively, to conclude the evidence.

In this view of the matter, this Court is not inclined to examine the instant petition on merits.
