This is the second petition filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.165 dated 03.07.2018 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 IPC (Sections 324 and 307 read with Section 34 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Dabwali Sadar, District Sirsa.

The earlier petition i.e. **CRM-M-35003 of 2018** filed by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn after issuing notice of motion vide order dated 23.10.2018 passed by this Court. Therefore, this Court finds that no ground is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Even otherwise, no change is pointed out in the case.

Accordingly, the present petition, being devoid of any merit, is dismissed.
