MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU, J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed praying for quashing of FIR No.0064 dated 30.11.2017 (**Annexure P-1**), under Sections 323, 279, 149 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3 of the Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, registered at Police Station Dorangla, District Gurdaspur along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (**Annexure P-2**) entered into between the parties.

This Court, while issuing notice of motion on 22.01.2018, directed the parties to appear before the learned trial Court and to get recorded their statements but none appeared before the learned trial Court and, therefore, their statements could not be recorded. Again on 28.02.2018, one more opportunity was granted to the parties to get recorded their statements on 23.03.2018.

On 23.03.2018 also, the position remained the same and again request was made on 25.04.2018 to grant one more opportunity and which was granted to the parties to get recorded their statements on 01.05.2018. Yet again, the position is the same. It seems that there is no compromise between the parties.

In view of above, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
