The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.88 dated 12.06.2015, registered under Sections 302, 307, 506, 120-B/34 of Indian Penal Code and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station Bagha Purana, District Moga.

It has been submitted that petitioner has not been named in the FIR, however, role attributed to him is similar to his co-accused Diljinder Singh, who has already been granted bail by this court vide order dated 18.12.2017 passed in *CRM-M-34777 of 2017*. Both Diljinder Singh and present petitioner were not armed with any weapon and only allegation against them was that they pointed towards the deceased. Nothing is to be recovered from the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case, this court is of the opinion that petitioner-Gurpreet Singh son of Tar Singh is entitled to bail on the basis of parity, therefore, the instant petition is allowed and he be extended the benefit of bail in the same terms as in *CRM-M-34777-2017*.
