The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 717 dated 14.08.2017, registered under Sections 307, 341, 120-B IPC and Sections 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Jhajjar.

As per the version, the petitioner and his co-accused fired at the complainant and his friends as a result of which injury was sustained on the head of one Dheeraj son of Baljit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed reliance upon the medical record of aforementioned Dheeraj son of Baljit to argue that the injury suffered by him is simple in nature. He also argues that the co-accused has been declared innocent by the police and challan has been presented only against the petitioner. The petitioner has been in custody since 15.08.2017 and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and, therefore, regular bail be granted to him. It is also

submitted that the petitioner does not have any criminal history.

The aforementioned submissions have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner – Jaibir Singh is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
