Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.182 dated 26.07.2018 registered under Section 379-B IPC at Police Station Kapurthala, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the allegation against the petitioner is that he alongwith another accused had snatched a mobile of the complainant. The petitioner is a young boy having no other criminal case against him and in case he is sent to custody, he may come in contact with some hardcore criminals.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Rana Harjasdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner, this Court finds that the allegation against the petitioner is snatching of a mobile and no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court and moves an application for regular bail, it is expected that the trial Court shall decide the same preferably within seven days, provided there is no other case against him of similar nature.
