This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 0408 dated 21.09.2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.

The petitioner was arrested on 22.09.2017.

It transpires that trial is in progress and so far only three out of fourteen witnesses have been examined.

From the chemical analysis report available in the case record it is seen that the quantum of contraband allegedly recovered from the petitioner was just 0.3 mg above the commercial quantity.

There is no involvement of the petitioner in any other case under the NDPS Act.

In the given circumstances considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court concerned.
