Manohar Lal-complainant lodged this FIR on the allegations that a sum of ₹6,48,900/- was illegally withdrawn from his Bank account No.03370100006817 maintained in UCO Bank, Circular Road, Bhiwani. The amount was allegedly transferred to the account of petitioner, namely, Jangsher son of Udey Singh, who has been indicted as an accused in this case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that in fact one Jitender Joggi in June, 2017 borrowed a sum of ₹64,000/- from him with a promise to return within a week. It is argued that Jitender Joggi had got amount of ₹6,48,900/- transferred in his account and the petitioner has returned the entire amount of Jitender Joggi except ₹64,000/-.

Considering the background of the case, particularly the fact that the petitioner offered his bank account for facilitating the crime, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Consequently, bail petition stands dismissed.
