Pursuant to the order dated 06.03.2018, another affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, City Narnaul, has been filed in Court today by learned State counsel, in which it is stated that two camels died in the police station after 12 were recovered, two already having died earlier.

Though otherwise the DSP who had earlier filed the affidavit would need to be reprimanded for filing that affidavit irresponsibly, however since learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued that the camels be continued to be looked after in the police station, with periodical checks of the veterinary surgeon, consequently, this petition is disposed of with the aforesaid direction, with liberty to the petitioner to file an application before the trial

It is made clear that nothing said by this Court in this petition shall be taken by the trial Court to be an observation with regard to the allegations in the FIR itself, which would be gone into wholly on the merits of the case.
