The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.225 dated 12.8.2017, registered at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa, under Sections 147, 148, 323, 365, 307, 120-B, 506 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959.

The petitioner was arrested on 27.10.2017 and was granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 18.4.2018. Thereafter, he was allegedly appearing on all dates, except on 29.10.2018 and therefore, his bail bonds have been cancelled.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was suffering from Enteric fever and was advised complete bed rest from 28.10.2018 to 30.10.2018 as is apparent from medical certificate, annexure P5. It was for this reason, he could not appear on 29.10.2018.

In case the petitioner could not put in appearance on account of his medical condition, he should have sought exemption from appearance on the said ground.

However, I feel that interest of justice would be better served, in case the petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court. Accordingly, petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 27.11.2018 and move an application for regular bail. On his doing so, the trial Court shall grant him regular bail subject to its satisfaction.
