Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 CrPC is for quashing of FIR No.100 dated 13.04.2015 under Sections 420, 380, 427, 448, 511, 120-B registered at Police Station Salem Tabri, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a *bona fide* purchaser of the property, as detailed in sale deed dated 15.12.2011 (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel submits that in the aforesaid FIR, the police has already completed the investigation and prepared the challan, however, the same could not filed in Court on account of stay granted by this Court.

Faced with this, counsel for the petitioner states that the present petition may be disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the concerned DCP for redressal of his grievance.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage. However, the petitioner is at liberty to approach the concerned DCP and submit his representation reflecting his view point. In case any such representation is filed, the same be decided in accordance with law.
