This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.506 dated 14.09.2017, under Sections 18/21 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sector-5, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

On 27.12.2017, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“Heard.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner herein was neither apprehended at the spot nor any recovery was effected from him. He was implicated only on the basis of disclosure statement of accused Rajesh Sharma. It is also contended that co-accused Kuldeep Sharma has already been granted the relief of interim anticipatory bail by this court in CRM-M-44283 of 2017.

Notice of motion for 05.02.2018.

*To be heard along with **CRM-M-44283 of 2017.***

Meanwhile, the petitioner is directed to join the investigation within a period of one week and on his doing so, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

State counsel upon instructions from ASI Karam Singh apprises the Court that the petitioner has since joined investigation.

The observations made by this Court in the order dated 27.12.2017 have gone unrebutted.

Petitioner is stated to be not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act.

For the reasons recorded above, prayer made in the petition is accepted.

Order dated 27.12.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute.
