The present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.92 dated 10.11.2017 registered under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code at Police Station Sadar Gurdaspur, District Gurdaspur.
