Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (Cr.P.C.) for grant of concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.201 dated 09.12.2017, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Division No.8, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of order dated 27.12.2017, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 24.02.2018 and his custodial interrogation is no longer required in this case.

The above factual position is duly acknowledged by learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Surender Kumar, by submitting that the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required any more.

In view of above, the interim order dated 27.12.2017 is hereby made absolute, subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the present petition stands disposed off.
