The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.576 dated 29.07.2015 titled as State through Drug Inspector Vs. Jatinder Gupta under Sections 18(c), 18A punishable under Section 27(b) (ii) and Section 28 of the Drugs & Cosmetics Act, 1940.

Perusal of the order dated 22.11.2017 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar (Annexure P-3) declining the concession of pre arrest bail would reveal that the petitioner in spite of having been summoned through bailable warrants followed by non-bailable warrants had not put in appearance. Thereafter, proclamation was issued and vide order dated 15.09.2017 petitioner was declared a proclaimed person. Such factual aspect is not disputed by counsel representing the petitioner.

Conduct of the petitioner disentitles him from the concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition dismissed.
