Application disposed of.

Main Case

This order shall dispose of the instant petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in complaint case No.COMA No.165 of 2013 dated 01.02.2012, under Sections 4 and 5 of Punjab Land Preservation Act, Indian Forest Act and Forest Conservation Act, 1980.

While issuing notice of motion, the following order was passed by this Court on 28.12.2017:-

“Inter alia submits that non-bailable

warrants have been issued by the trial Court in a

complaint case, on account of the nonappearance of the petitioner, who is 70 years old, vide order dated 11.12.2017 (Annexure P-3). It is submitted that he is suffering from Cancer with Type-II Diabetes (Annexure P-2) and is a resident of New Delhi. Counsel submits that the petitioner shall put in appearance on 11.01.2018, which is the next date fixed before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Suveer Sheokand, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Copy of the paper-book has been supplied.

Adjourned to 06.02.2018.

In the meantime, on appearance of the petitioner, the trial Court shall accept fresh bail bonds and surety bonds of the petitioner and not take him into custody.”

Placed on record at Annexure P-4 is a certified copy of order dated 11.01.2018 passed by the trial Court and a perusal of the same would reveal that the petitioner has duly appeared before the Court below and has been admitted to interim bail upon furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.35000/- with one surety in the like amount.

Petitioner having joined trial proceedings, prayer made

in the instant petition is accepted.

Order dated 28.12.2017, passed by this Court is made absolute.
