The petitioner is the respondent-accused in a complaint filed under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881. She has been declared a proclaimed person vide order dated 19.3.2018. Thus, the present petition has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, the petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to surrender before the trial Court on or before 27.11.2018 and move an application for regular bail. On her doing so, the trial Court shall grant her regular bail subject to its satisfaction. It is made clear that in case of a single default in appearance before the trial Court, the petitioner would be dis-entitled to grant of bail in future.
