The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.247 dated 12.11.2017, under Sections 366, 380 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Pursuant to the previous order, balance amount of ₹ 30,000/- has been handed over to learned counsel for the complainant by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that on the direction of this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and nothing is to be recovered from them.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from the Investigating Officer, submits that petitioners have joined the investigation and they are not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioners are not required for custodial interrogation and have joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 01.01.2018 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
