INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner Jagmohan Singh has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.21 dated 31.01.2018, registered at Police Station Jhansa, District Kurukshetra (Haryana), under Sections 21 and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Notice of motion has been issued.

Learned State counsel appeared and contested the instant petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and gone through the record.

As per the prosecution version, 6 grams of smack has been recovered from co-accused Rajbir Singh @ Kaka and Harvinder Singh @ Golu. The present petitioner has been nominated on the disclosure statements of co-accused that they have purchased it from the present

petitioner. Admittedly, the recovery effected from the co-accused false in non-commercial quantity.

The petitioner has been in custody since 01.02.2018. He is not required for any investigation or interrogation purposes as he is in judicial custody. The trial of the case may take long time. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody till the final disposal of the case.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case; without discussing the facts in minute detail and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, this criminal miscellaneous petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of ₹40,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.
