The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.0208 dated 09.10.2018 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 365, 379B, 506 & 511 IPC, registered at Police Station Sanoli, District Panipat.

Heard.

In the other connected matter, parties have already moved for compromise quashing and their statements have been ordered to be recorded.

Petitioner was arrested on 14.10.2018.

Considering the fact that the parties have moved for compromise, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on

bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed.
