Petitioner-Satpal has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.724 dated 08.09.2017, under Sections 379-A, 511 & 420 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

The petitioner was arrested on 07.09.2017 and was granted regular bail vide order dated 12.10.2017 by the trial Court. During trial, he absented on two consecutive dates, however, he filed application for exemption supported by the medical certificate, which was declined by the trial Court. He surrendered before the trial Court on 26.10.2018 and is in custody since then. Considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody for last about one month, there is no justification for further detention of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is

ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

It is made clear that if the petitioner will seek exemption for personal appearance without getting the order prior to the date fixed and in any case, he will absent, the trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.
