Prayer made in this petition is for issuance of necessary directions to the official respondents No.2 and 3 in the context of protection of lives and personal liberties of the petitioners from being invaded at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that respondent No.5 has acted like an executing officer for getting the rented shop vacated without there being any order by the competent Court.

Learned counsel further submitted that petitioners are the tenants in the premises belonging to respondent No.6 for which respondents No.5 and 6 in collusion, have pressurized the petitioners to vacate the same without approaching the Court of law.

Precisely for the grievance in question, petitioners have

also moved a complaint before respondent No.3 on 01.02.2018 highlighting their grievances qua the involvement of respondent No.5 and the said complaint is pending consideration before him.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab, accepted notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Let requisite copies of the petition be supplied to him by learned counsel for the petitioner during course of the day.

In view of nature of order, which this Court proposes to pass there is no necessity of calling upon reply at this stage.

At this stage, without meaning anything on the pleadings contained in the present petition, respondent No.2 is directed to take into consideration the pending complaint moved by the petitioners on 01.02.2018 and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without being swayed away by any consideration in terms of pleadings or anything recorded in the preceding part of the order.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
