This is a petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 177 dated 10.10.2018 under Section 22 (notification No. 61) of Narcotic Drugs Psychotropic Substance Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Nihal Singh Wala, District Moga.

It comes out that petitioner was not apprehended at the spot. However, his wife was apprehended and the alleged recovery is of 25 strips of TRIO-SR (containing 250 tablets) and 16 strips of tablets make Calv-SR (160 tablets).

Therefore, no ground is made to grant anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.
