Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC is for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.5 and for restraining the respondent No.5 from taking forcible possession of the vehicle of the petitioner.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is ready to appear before the respondent No.5 and to clear the upto date outstanding amount within a period of one month from today.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Rana Harjasdeep Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting anything upon merits of the case, but considering the fact that the petitioner has shown his inclination to clear the outstanding amount, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the respondent No.5 and to clear the entire outstanding loan amount within a period of one month from today. During this period, the respondent No.5 shall not take the forcible possession of the vehicle of the petitioner.
