Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.509 dated 26.04.2018 under Sections 454, 380 IPC registered at Police Station City Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

At the outset, learned State counsel has produced a list of cases registered against the petitioner, which reads as under:-

The argument raised on behalf of the petitioner that in view of Section 437(6) CrPC and the fact that the petitioner is on bail in all the cases except in FIR No.330 dated 26.03.2018 and FIR No.509 dated 26.04.2018, the petitioner be admitted on bail, cannot be accepted. The cases registered against the petitioner reveals that he is involved in number of cases, which are serious enough to decline him the bail.

Even otherwise, counsel for the State has submitted that as of now, the trial in the said cases is at advance stage, as all the witnesses except one prosecution witness, have been examined and the case is fixed for today itself for examination of the remaining prosecution witness.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
