INDERJIT SINGH, J.

Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for brevity, 'Cr.P.C.') for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.375 dated 20.09.2018, registered at Police Station Sadar Fatehabad, under Sections 420, 406, 120-B and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3, 4, 5 and 6 of the Prize Chits and Money Circulation Scheme (Banning) Act, 1978.

Notice of motion was issued in this case. Learned State counsel has put in appearance on behalf of the respondent-State and contested this petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel and have gone through the record.

From the record, I find that FIR, in the present case, has been registered on the basis of a written complaint given by Mohan Lal son of

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Mahender Singh against Future Vision Company and its Directors Harkishan Kamboj and Amar Singh Jangra (present petitioner) and Jaswinder Kaur Nurse wife of Harkishan Kamboj for committing act of cheating. It is stated by the complainant that the aforesaid persons being acquainted with him, visited him and disclosed about the plan floated by Future Vision Company and in case of investment with them, he would get three times returns on the investment value and would also get luxury cars. On their allurements, he handed over an amount of ₹3,80,000/- in cash to Hari Kishan Kamboj and the present petitioner. It is also stated in the FIR that they had also again transferred ₹80,000/- from the UCO Bank account of Harkishan.

Learned State counsel has brought to the notice of this Court that so many persons have been cheated by the present petitioner and statements of about 20 persons have been recorded in respect of cheating.

I have also gone through the police file. In their statements, so many persons have named the present petitioner as Managing Director of Future Vision Company.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case and in view of the fact that so many persons have been cheated by the Company of which the present petitioner is stated to be a Director/Managing Director, I find that he is required for custodial interrogation. No ground is made out for granting the benefit of anticipatory bail to the present petitioner.

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Therefore, finding no merit in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
