This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 421 dated 18.7.2018 under Section 13(3) of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015, registered at Police Station Nuh, District Nuh, Mewat, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that 50 KG beef was being carried out by the petitioner along with the co-accused-Hamid who has been granted regular bail on 13.8.2018 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Mewat.

In this case, petitioner was arrested on 18.7.2018 and is in custody since then. Challan in this case is stated to have been presented. All the offences are triable by the Magistrate.

Since the disposal of challan will take long time, further detention of the present petitioner will be unjustified.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
