During the course of interaction with the petitioner as well as complainant/respondent No.2, both the sides have shown their resolve to the settlement/agreement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court, true copy of which is annexed with the file as Annexure P-2.

Further, it has come across during the course of submissions of the two sides that the original settlement/agreement arrived at between the parties by way of Mediation Case No. 2457 of 2018, original report of the Mediator dated 30.10.2018 alongwith the original settlement/agreement due to inadvertence has been placed on the file of CRM M-25425 of 2018 (O&M) whereas it ought to have been placed on the file of the present petition. Office to place it at appropriate place.

Heard.

Since the parties have resolved all of their disputes and have made statements before this Court duly endorsed by their respective counsel accepting the terms and conditions detailed in settlement/agreement (Annexure P-2) and undertake to abide by the same, thus, separate recording of the statement is not necessitated and the fact that the dispute between the parties being a pure matrimonial and the offences for which the accused have been hauled up are not of serious nature, together with the fact that compromise will go a long way in ironing out differences for betterment of future life of the parties and in view of the law laid down in '**Gian Singh Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2012 (4) RCR (Criminal) 543 and '**Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**' 2007 (3) RCR (Criminal) 1052, the prayer made in the petition is allowed, proceedings by way of FIR No. 70 dated 16.03.2018 registered at Police Station Pinjore District Panchkula under Sections 323, 377, 406, 498-A and 511 IPC and all consequences arising out of the said FIR qua the petitioners are quashed.

The petition stands allowed in those terms.
