The petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 439 of Criminal Procedure Code for grant of regular bail in FIR No.184 dated 19.12.2017, under Sections 406, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar.

It is submitted that the petitioner is neither the party nor the witness to the agreement to sell. However, it is undisputed that he identified the proper person. He is in custody for the last eight months and twenty seven days.

Learned State Counsel opposed the bail on the ground that he is involved in other cases.

Keeping in view the peculiar circumstances of the case, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to furnishing personal bond with one surety to the satisfaction of the learned Area/Duty Magistrate concerned and subject to the conditions, if so imposed, by that court.
