The petitioner applied for renewal of his arms licence in January, 2017. Thereafter, an FIR No.28 was registered against him on 15.2.2017, under Section 420 IPC. Consequently, vide order dated 25.10.2017, the competent authority refused to recommend the renewal of the arms licence.

It is contended on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner was found innocent by the police and cancellation report dated 10.7.2018 was presented. The complainant objected to the said report and the objection petition has been treated as a complaint vide order dated 7.8.2018. Thereafter, a second application dated 28.9.2018 has been filed for renewal of the arms licence, but the licence has not been renewed till date.

From the aforementioned facts, it is apparent that no order has been passed rejecting the second application dated 28.9.2018 and thus, the petition is premature and the same is dismissed as such.
