The petitioner has filed this petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail in FIR No.138 dated 10.08.2018 under Sections 379, 379-B, 411, 420, 471 of Indian Penal Code and Prevention of the Tempering of the Mobile Device Equipment Identification Number Rules, 2017, registered at Police Station Sadar Mansa, District Mansa.

Heard.

Accused was arrested on 10.08.2018 and he is in custody since then.

Learned counsel for the petitioner produced a copy of the order dated 27.11.2018 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench in CRM-M-47603-2018, wherein, two other co-accused in this case, have been released on

bail.

Therefore, on the ground of parity the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Accordingly, the petition stands allowed.
