KULDIP SINGH J. (Oral)

In this case, 8 grams Ganja and 500 grams Psychotropic intoxicating powder was recovered from the petitioner, which is commercial in nature. Petitioner was arrested on 24.3.2017.

Learned State counsel has informed that the challan was presented on 9.9.2017 and out of 10 witnesses, 5 witnesses have been examined. Since, it is case of recovery of commercial quantity, there is no ground to grant bail.

Resultantly, the present petition is dismissed.

However, the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial within six months, preferably by examining remaining witnesses by holding day-to-day trial.
