The petitioner herein has filed this petition under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 200 dated 21.6.2018, under Sections 323, 354-A, 452 and 506 IPC and Section 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences act, 2012 registered at Police Station Sadar, Gohana, District Sonapat.

It is contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and this is a case of cross-version as the petitioner has also lodged FIR No. 203 dated 25.6.2018 under Sections 323 and 324 at Police Station Sadar Gohana with regard to the same incident. It is also contended that challan has already been presented and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required. The trial is likely to take some time. No useful purpose would be served by keeping the

petitioner behind bars till the conclusion of the trial. He prays that the petitioner be admitted to regular bail.

Ms. Gaganpreet Kaur, learned AAG, Haryana has contested the bail application while submitting that the allegations levelled against the petitioner are of serious nature and as such he does not deserves the concession of regular bail.

Without going into the merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that challan has already been presented and the trial is likely to take some time to conclude, the present petition is accepted and the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
