The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.66 dated 13.06.2018 registered at Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot, under Sections 452, 324, 323, 148 and 149 IPC (Sections 325, 326 and 450 IPC added later on and Section 452 IPC deleted later on).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 15.06.2018. The investigation is complete, but the charge has yet not been framed. Thus, the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date. The petitioner does not have any other criminal case pending against him and therefore, he may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 27.11.2018 filed by Lalit Kumar Kohli, PPS, Deputy Superintendent, Central Prison Faridkot, has been filed in the Court today, which is taken on record. According to which the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 05 months and 12 days and there is no other case pending or decided against him.

The factual submissions made by counsel for the petitioner have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner-Amandeep Singh, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
