Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a complaint has been moved by the petitioner on 18.7.2018 (Annexure P-2) before the Station House Officer, Police Station, Nurmahal. He further submits that a representation dated 12.9.2018 (Annexure P-4) has been moved before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, (Rural) Jalandhar but no action has been taken on the same.

In the circumstance, present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to appear before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Rural, Jalandhar who shall inform the petitioner about the fate of her complaint. If the petitioner is not satisfied, she is at liberty to approach the Illaqa Magistrate concerned with her written complaint for appropriate remedy.
