The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 242 dated 30.11.2017 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 of IPC and Section 6 of the POCSO Act, Police Station Ellenabad, District Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is in custody since 26.12.2017 and charge has been framed and the complainant and the victim have been examined. Counsel further submits that the girl had the occasion to run away and it was a case of affair between the two and the trial is taking time.

The State counsel opposes the prayer and states that the trial is proceeding at a fast pace and 10 witnesses out of 15 have been examined.

The counsel further submits that the girl was 15 years old and the FSL report has been received, which is positive. The counsel submits that the girl was away from the house for 13 days and she had been violated.

The allegations against the petitioner are of enticing a minor and raping her. The girl was just 15 years old. She has alleged that she was intoxicated and taken away. The trial is going at a fast pace. The allegations are serious. I am not inclined to grant bail.

The petition is dismissed. However, the trial Court is directed to expedite the trial.
