The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case registered vide FIR No.89 dated 9.5.2018 under Sections 307, 323, 506 & 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Moga, District Moga.

The allegations in nut-shell are that after the complainant had come out of the examination hall, he was attacked by Gurpreet Singh, Sunny and another boy. While Gurpreet Singh is alleged to have given slap to the complainant, Sunny is stated to have fired at the complainant

with a revolver.

Notice of the petition was issued to the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in fact the matter has been resolved amicably amongst the parties, who are all students and has drawn the attention of this Court to a compromise deed, Annexure P-1 and an affidavit of the complainant Annexure P-2.

Today, Sh. Deepak Gupta, Advocate is present on behalf of the complainant and has filed power of attorney, which is taken on record. He has admitted the factum of compromise.

Although the application has been opposed by learned State counsel but bearing in mind that parties have amicably resolved the matter and also that the challan has already been filed, in my opinion, no fruitful purpose would be served by further detaining the petitioner behind bars. Accordingly, petitioner-Gurpreet Singh @ Gora is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Moga.

This petition stands accepted accordingly.
