Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.12 dated 24.02.2018 under Sections 457, 380 IPC and Sections 411, 420, 482, 465, 467, 468, 471, 474, 485 IPC (added later on), registered at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the order dated 28.11.2018 passed in CRM-M-31389-2018 (Gansham Versus State of Punjab), whereby the co-accused was admitted on regular bail by this Court. He states that the petitioner is in custody since 14.06.2018 and trial in the case is likely to take long time.

Learned State Counsel does not dispute the custody period and the fact that co-accused Gansham has been admitted on bail by this Court.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Considering the fact that co-accused has already been admitted on bail by this Court vide order dated 28.11.2018 passed in CRM-M-31389-2018, petitioner is in custody since 14.06.2018, coupled with the fact that trial in the case is likely to take long time, I deem it appropriate to admit the petitioner on regular bail.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
